How to add, edit, remove and reinstate an Organisation to a patient's Circle of Care in the DCR



This user guide will show you how to manage an Organisation from a patient's **Circle of Care** in the **DCR**. Organisations can be added to a patient's record as support for the patient - the organisation does not have to be a DCR user to be added in. The patient cannot make any changes to the **Organisations** category.

Please note the **Circle of Care** is an **UNMONITORED** service i.e. there will be no notifications to you or your patient of any changes or updates made to the patient's **Circle of Care**.


1. Finding the Circle of Care from the Summary tab in the DCR



- Access the citizen's DCR record either via single sign-on from the DCR tab/link within your current organisational system, or login via the DCR browser https://prof.dorsetcarerecord.nhs.uk/concerto/Login.htm and search for the patient. The patient record opens on the Summary tab.
- 2 Click on the Circle of Care.




You can also access the Circle of Care from the my Dorset Care Record tab. They both show the same information.



Finding the Circle of Care from my Dorset Care Record tab




Click on my Dorset Care Record, and then click on the Circle of Care.



2. The Circle of Care in the DCR is mirrored in myDCR, under the patient's My Support Network





3. How to add an Organisation to the patient's Circle of Care



To add a member to the Circle of Care, click on Add.


You can add a member to the following:

Organisations can be added to a patient's record as support for the patient. The organisation does not have to be a DCR user to be added in.

The patient is not able to make any changes to the **Organisations** category.




Adding an Organisation to a patient's Circle of Care



- 4 Select the Organisation radio button.
- Complete the mandatory fields marked with a red Asterix: Name*, Organisation Type*, Start Date*

You can add in a phone number or an email address under **Add Contact Details** and the patient will be able to see these in their myDCR and contact the Organisation as needed.




6 Click on Add.

4. Editing the details for an Organisation




- Click on the Organisation line from the Organisations category.
- 8 Click on Edit.
- Make any amendments, as necessary.
 You can Deactivate the organisation, but you cannot delete them.

When deactivated, the organisation will no longer show under Organisations. Rather, you will find them under **Show Inactive**.




- Click on the Organisation's line and in the expanded box that opens click on Edit.

6. A deactivated member can be re-activated: Reactivating Organisations



- Click on **Show Inactive** to see all **Organisations**, both inactive/deactivated and active.
- Click on their name/line.
- 24 Click on Edit.
- When a member is deactivated, the Deactivate box is relabelled as Activate.
 Under Activate, select Now or On date.
 The Deactivate box will appear right under Activate for you to select a date for deactivation.
- 26 Click on **Update**.
- Click on **Hide Inactive** to only show active **Organisations** in the patient's Circle of Care.




