To search for a patient, you can use the patient's

NHS Number,


 Other Identifier such as a Local Hospital Identifier,

 A combination of the First Name, Surname and Born date,

 A wild card: enter Born Date and the first three letters of the First Name or Surname, each followed by a % sign

and click Search

Accessed to find a patient whose
record you've viewed recently.


## Accessing a patient's record



If searching by NHS number or Other Identifier, only one patient should appear in the Results table below the Search button.

If searching by name and DOB, more than one patient may appear - please ensure correct patient selected.

Click on the relevant patient anywhere in the Results table.






