Alerts



The **Partners** contributing Alerts information in the **DCR** are

- Dorset Council for Adults data. Examples include potential injury risk from home environment, adults warning, missing persons, Trading Standards client susceptible/subject to financial abuse, safeguarding alerts, firearms, history of violence from service user, risk of injury from animals/pets.
- Bournemouth Christchurch Poole Council pending for Adults data and social care
- Dorset County Hospital Examples include medical conditions including possible cases of tuberculosis and previous pressure ulcer alerts, Munchausen syndrome and mental disorders, child safeguarding and social alerts, such as patient notes, armed forces information and patients who have multiple aliases.
- Dorset HealthCare Community
- NHS Dorset/GPs
- Community Substance Misuse Services known as Reach across the DC area and With Are With You, or simply With You, across the BCP area pending for Summer 2024. Examples include alcohol dependent, at risk of harm from others/vulnerable person, Hepatitis C Positive, known alcohol related liver disease, known engagement with mental health services, known intravenous drug user, known victim of domestic abuse, prescribed opiate substitute therapy, risk of harm to others, risk of harm to self, risk to children.

Where to find Alerts in the DCR - Please note the same Alerts information may be displayed in multiple places in the DCR for ease of use.





The badge will remain visible in the patient banner as you navigate between the tabs.








Expanding the view of an INACTIVE alert



Expanding the view of an INACTIVE alert will allow additional information to be viewed, for example, the date the alert was closed. Please note that there is an inconsistency in the terminology being used for inactive alerts, depending on which part of the DCR is being viewed. Inactive alerts can show as 'Resolved' or 'Inactive'.

In this example, we can see

- the alert is showing as closed on the left-hand side,
- the status is showing as resolved and
- the 'Closed On' field is populated with a date.




3. Alerts on the Summary tab Front Screen – same data as on the Problem List tab




Showing Active Alerts (i.e. not finished) on the Front Screen and All Alerts when maximised. To maximise, click on the square button next to the Active Alerts heading.


Example Active Alert from Community Misuse Services to show in the DCR from Summer 2024



Summary tab – Maximised View of Alerts




- 1 Showing All Alerts (including inactive) when maximised To get this view, click on the maximising square button next to the Active Alerts heading. Active Alerts -

2 To return to the Summary tab front screen, click on the tab again.




Alerts from Dorset HealthCare Community on the Summary tab under Community (Problems and Issues)


