Demographics



Comprehensive and the latest demographic information for a patient can be found in the DCR on the **Summary** tab under:

- the Person Banner and
- Additional details.

The demographic information includes personal and contact details and is fed overnight from the PDS (Personal Demographic Service)/NHS Spine first, and then anything extra not in the PDS comes from the Partner systems, if any additional info is available.

The **Partners** contributing demographic information are

- Dorset Council for both Adults and Children's data,
- Bournemouth Christchurch Poole Council for Adults data only,
- Dorset County Hospital
- University Hospitals Dorset
- Dorset HealthCare Mental Health
- Community Substance Misuse Services Reach across the DC area and With Are With You, or simply With You, across
 the BCP area.



Demographics in the DCR Person Banner

In the **Person Banner**, you can find the patient's date of birth, gender, address, contact details, NHS and PDS numbers, as well as their current GP practice.



If the patient is deceased, this is indicated by the presence of the **Deceased badge** alongside their name, and you can also see the date of death and age at death.





Demographics under Additional Details


On the **Summary** tab under **Additional Details**, there are more personal details such as ethnicity, nationality, language and whether an interpreter is required, religion and marital status, race, disability and whether living alone. Please also see next

Demographics under Additional Details Continued




The **Person's Contact** section at the bottom of the page is where you will find a person's next of kin and other relationships information fed from the local authorities, the acutes and DHC Mental Health.



Demographics under Additional Details – Person's Contact


Please note that relationships information can also be added manually into the **DCR** from the **my Dorset Care Record** tab under the **Circle of Care** functionality by health and social care professionals as well as by the patient from their **myDCR**.



Demographics under Additional Details – If the person is deceased



If the patient is deceased, this is indicated by the presence of the **Deceased badge** alongside their name, and you can also see the date of death and age at death. Same information is displayed both in the Person Banner and under Additional Details.




Demographics under Additional Details – If the person is known to the Community Substance Misuse Services



The data from the Community Substance Misuse Services - Reach (DC) and With you (BCP), where available, will be visible alongside all other available data for the person. The data is fed from the HALO CMS system and a HALO ID will be visible in the **Additional Details** section of the **DCR** as shown below and will appear alongside any other local identifiers such as hospital numbers. Please note that the HALO data will only populate fields in the **DCR** if they are not already populated with data from another source.

Please also note that any address data feeding from HALO will populate the 'HOME' address field – the address data from all other sources populates the 'MAIN PERMANENT' address field - so there will be instances where more than one address is showing.
