






Encounters on the Summary Front Screen – Expanded view


The maximise square button provides you with interactivity and is an enabler for further information. Clicking on either of the maximise buttons next to Current or History both take you to the same page where the Current, Future and Past activity is

altogether shown.



Seeing these encounters makes it much easier and quicker to find where the patient is and/or their status.


The encounters history will also help you identify a patient who frequently visits for support and care services.




