There are two Cancer results documents available in the DCR

- 1. There is a Cancer results document which comes into the DCR directly from the Partner source system, and
- 2. A Cancer results document which comes into the DCR indirectly, after it has been through the Remote Monitoring System (RMS) and the Partner's TIE where the document is converted into a pdf format.


This user guide will show you where each of these documents can be found in the DCR.

Locating the 2 Cancer results documents in the DCR



On the left hand side of the Summary tab, you will find **Specialties** (e.g. Pathology, Radiology) and the **Patient held records**.

- 1. The **Cancer results** document which comes **directly** from the Partner source system into the DCR can be found under the **Specialties** (e.g. Pathology, Radiology).
- 2. The Cancer results document which comes indirectly from the Partner source system via the Remote Monitoring System (RMS) and the Partner's TIE can be found under the Patient held records.



1. Finding the Cancer results document that comes into the DCR *directly* from the Partner source system.




NOTE

This results document comes directly from the Partner's source system.

It is an existing direct feed from the Partner's source system into the DCR.

- Click on the relevant
 Specialty and Associated
 Subsection (e.g.
 Pathology/Chemistry,
 Radiology/MRI).
- Find the correct **Date** for the document you are looking for (e.g. 22-Jan-2022 PSA).
- Click on the **Document** to select it.



2. Finding the Cancer results document that comes into the DCR *indirectly* from the Partner source system via the Remote Monitoring System (RMS).





The Partner's TIE converts the results into a **pdf** format, as can be seen in the screenshot on the right.
