

DCR Quick Start Guide: Let's explore the Summary tab

Access **GP and Community data** under these tabs; this data is not amalgamated within panels or Sidebar tables.

Multiple Community units may be displayed, and you may need to scroll using the arrows to see them all.

Without leaving the current record, **search for another record by the NHS number**.

Return to the **Person search page** to search for a record by the NHS number or demographics.

Toggle data providers

Use the Timeline tab to identify interaction patterns.

Use the Feed tab to filter interactions by type and date.

See additional demographics including **next of kin and emergency contacts**.

Sidebar: Panel headers show panel data in tables.

Click **arrow** to hide Sidebar.

Panels:

- Click underlined panel names to see panel data in a table.
- Filter panel data by active/most recent or overall number of records.
- When the panel's overall records filter shows more than 100 records, the active/most recent filter on the left will not show.
- Open several panels at the same time for consideration.

- Always check **Flags** = Alerts, and **Allergies and Adverse Reactions**
- **Complex Medications** = All To Take Out discharge medications from DCH. See also GP Data for primary care prescribing.
- **Documents** = Discharge letters and summaries, including UHD Inpatient Discharge Summaries, and End of Life Care Plan if available.
- **Appointments** = Future events; **Encounters** = Past or current events. Events may appear under both categories with a corresponding status when an appointment has passed and an encounter has occurred.
- **Healthcare Referrals** = Includes both health and social care referrals!
- **Diagnostic Reports** = Includes Pathology, Radiology and Other reports

Coloured demographic banner:

- Blue for adults
- Pink for children
- Grey for deceased

Blue Badges alert you to active information under **Flags** and **Allergies and Adverse Reactions**.

The badges continue to show as you move within the record.

Clicking on a badge takes you to the detailed table view also available from the Sidebar.
