It includes diagnosis and events e.g. fall, drug overdose, safeguarding concerns, child protection plan, pregnancies and social issues such as bereavement or unemployment. It shows active and inactive major and minor problems and issues.

The **Clinical Report** contains information relating to the clinical care, health or wellbeing of the patient. This can include:

- childhood and travel vaccinations
- screening information
- past medical history.

Observations include repeatable data from health professionals during assessment or care of their patient. It includes pathology results e.g. Alkaline phosphatase liver isoenzyme level, weight, height, BMI, pulse rate, blood pressure results, patient health questionnaire results, temperature, oxygen levels, frailty scores.

Encounters include planned pre-arranged appointments with the GP, unplanned encounters at an OOH clinic and those unrecorded through appointment modules, direct face-to-face encounters, indirect encounters i.e. the GP reviewing and updating the patient's record on receipt of some tests results.

Encounters can be filtered by date.

Examples of GP encounters entries:

- Acute and community admissions and discharges
- Ambulance episodes
- Appointment and outcomes e.g. DNAs
- Care arrangements
- Changes to patient preferences
- Consent
- Contacts e.g. daughter responsible for parent's affairs
- Dates/types of communication, but not the content e.g. email to xx re: Covid or telephone conversation with xx about xxx
- Diagnosis
- GSF Prognosis indicator – framework for end of life care
- Incidents e.g. suicide attempt
- Observations and doctor's response e.g. results normal, no further action
- Pathology requests
- Patient health questionnaire results
- Prescriptions
- Public protection notice references (but not content)
- Reference to police incident report (but not content)
- Referrals
- Reminder/alerts e.g. patient has a carer
- Reviews e.g. multidisciplinary reviews (MDTs), dementia care plans
- Safeguarding checks and concerns
- Texts sent to patients

Immunisations provides information about any immunisations that have been administered to the patient e.g. Covid vaccine, flu vaccine, tetanus, vaccines against pneumonia and bacterial infections etc., childhood vaccines e.g. measles, mumps and rubella.

All Medication

Medications provides a history of medications prescribed including the acute medications over the last 12 months, current repeat medication and discontinued repeat medication, all medication and medication issues.

Medications Issues show when an authorised medication has been turned into an order, usually a prescription. Authorised medications may, therefore, have multiple issues e.g. repeat prescriptions. Medications issues will not show whether the person has collected the medication from a pharmacy.

Medications can be filtered by date – however this will only apply to the sections All Medications and All Medication Issues; the remaining sections will return all records.
